

PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS

PERMIT REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the business of peddler as defined in section 52.020 of this ordinance within the corporate limits of this city without first obtaining a permit therefore as provided herein.

"PEDDLER" DEFINED. The word "peddler" as used herein shall include any person, whether a resident of this city or not, traveling by foot, wagon, automotive vehicle, or any other type of conveyance, from place to place, from house to house, or from street to street, carrying, conveying or transporting goods, wares, merchandise, meats, fish, vegetables, fruits, garden truck, farm products or provisions, offering and exposing the same for sale, or making sales and delivering articles to purchasers, or offering for sale for later delivery, or seeking appointments for purpose of, at time, offering for sale; or who, without traveling from place to place, shall sell or offer the same for sale from a wagon, automotive vehicle, railroad car, or other vehicle or conveyance; and further provided that one who solicits orders and as a separate transaction makes deliveries to purchasers as a part of a scheme or design to evade the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a peddler subject to the provisions of this ordinance. The word "peddler" shall include the words "hawker", "huckster", and "solicitor".

- 1. "Peddler: does not include a farmer selling his own produce grown on his farm.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT. Applicants for permits under this ordinance must file with the city clerk a sworn application in writing (in duplicate) on a form to be furnished by the city clerk, which shall give the following information.

Give a brief description of the nature of the business and the goods to be sold and in the case of products of farm or orchard, whether produced or grown by the applicant.

If employed, the name and address of the employer, together with credentials establishing the exact relationship. _____

If a vehicle is to be used, a description of the same, together with credentials establishing the license number or other means of identification. _____

Has applicant been convicted of any crime, misdemeanor, or violation of any municipal ordinance, the nature of the offense and the punishment or penalty assessed therefor.

FEES. The fees for licenses required under this chapter shall be as established from time to time by ordinance of the board of aldermen and on file in this office of the city clerk. \$ _____

PERMIT NONTRANSFERABLE. No permit issued under this chapter shall be transferable or assignable.

EXHIBITION OF PERMIT. Peddlers are required to exhibit their license at the request of any citizen.
