

## APPROVED COMMUNITY SERVICE LIST

- ✓ Work must be performed without compensation for a not-for-profit business.
- ✓ The approved places for community service include government entities, religious organizations, food banks, blood centers, homeless shelters, etc.
- ✓ Someone from the agency that you have performed work for must track your hours and dates worked. The agency is to provide you with the information on a signed letterhead or volunteer form from the company or organization indicating the dates and hours worked, which you must return to the court.
- ✓ If you turn in proof of completion of your community service 5 days prior to your court, you can call the Municipal Court Clerk's office at 573-288-4412 on the day before your court date to see if your community service was approved and if you are required to appear in court.
