AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 797-C OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSOURI, BY AMENDING SECTION TWO DESCRIBING OCCUPATIONS THAT MUST OBTAIN A LICENSE AND AMENDING SECTION SEVEN, PARAGRAPH 2, TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS OBTAINING OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES IN THE CITY OF CANTON MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF FIRE, WINDSTORM AND EXTENDED COVERAGE INSURANCE ON ANY STRUCTURE WHERE BUSINESS IS OPERATED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Section Two of Ordinance No. 797-C amended. That from and after the effective date and adoption and approval of this amending ordinance, Section Two of Ordinance No. 797-C shall be amended and shall hereafter be and appear as follows:

“SECTION TWO. Occupations exempt from the occupational license fee. The following occupations are exempt from the provisions of this ordinance and are not required to obtain an occupational license or provide proof of insurance:

1. Minister;
2. Teacher;
3. Priest;
4. Attorney-at-Law;
5. Certified Public Accountant;
6. Dentist;
7. Chiropractor;
8. Optometrist;
9. Physician;
10. Christian Science Practitioner;
11. Insurance Agent;
12. Chiropodist;
13. Professor in a College;
14. Veterinarian;
15. Architect;

16. Professional Engineer;
17. Land Surveyor;
18. Auctioneer;
19. Real Estate Broker or Salesman.”

SECTION TWO. Section Seven, 2, amended. That from and after the effective date and adoption and approval of this amending ordinance, Section Seven, 2, of Ordinance No. 797-C shall be amended and shall hereafter be and appear as follows:

“2. The following information shall be provided to the City at the time the application for an occupational license is applied for:

(a) A Certificate of Insurance from the Insurance Company providing fire, windstorm and extended coverage insurance on the building where the business is operated, certifying coverage of not less than \$50,000.

(b) As an alternative to (a), the applicant may provide a current copy of the fire, windstorm and extended coverage policy.”

SECTION THREE. Remainder of Ordinance No. 797-C ratified and confirmed. All portions of Ordinance No. 797-C not herein specifically amended or repealed shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION FOUR. Prior inconsistent ordinances repealed. All prior ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with or inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION FIVE. Severability. Each of the provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any provision shall be declared to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION SIX. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect from and after it has been made available to the general public by posting a copy thereof in the City Office, 106 North Fifth Street, Canton, Missouri, as provided by law, after it has been read by title two times before the Board of Aldermen of the City of Canton, Missouri, after it has been adopted by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Canton, Missouri, and approved by the Mayor of the City of Canton, Missouri.

## City of Canton Hold Harmless

1) To the fullest extent permitted by law, Sponsor agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Canton, its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from and against all suits, claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including but not limited to attorneys' fees, court costs, or alternative dispute resolution costs arising out of, or related to, Sponsor's use of City streets, roads, parks, sidewalk or other facilities under this agreement involving an injury to a person or persons, whether bodily injury or other personal injury (including death), or involving an injury or damage to property (including loss of use or diminution in value), but only to the extent that such suits, claims, damages, losses or expenses are caused by the negligence or other wrongdoing of Sponsor, its officers, agents and volunteers, or anyone directly or indirectly employed or hired by Sponsor or anyone for whose acts Sponsor may be liable, regardless of whether caused in part by the negligence or wrongdoing of City and any of its agents or employees

2) Sponsor shall purchase and maintain the following insurance, at Sponsor's expense:

Commercial General Liability Insurance with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 each occurrence /\$2,000,000 general aggregate written on an occurrences bases. Comprehensive Business Automobile Liability Insurance for all owned, non-owned and hired automobiles and other vehicles used by Sponsor with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 minimum.

Workers Compensation insurance with statutorily limits required by any applicable Federal or State Law and Employers Liability insurance with minimum limit of \$1,000,00 per accident

3) All policies of insurance must be on primary basis, non-contributory with any other insurance and/or self-insurance carried by the City.

4) Prior to using City's facilities or infrastructure under this agreement, Sponsor shall furnish the City with certificates of insurance evidencing the required coverage, conditions, and limits required by this agreement, have the City named as an additional insured and provide the appropriate additional insured endorsements/certificate of endorsement.

5) No provision of this agreement shall constitute a waiver of the City's right to assert a defense based on the doctrines of sovereign immunity, official immunity, or any other immunity available under law.
